If your birthday falls in June please plan to attend the Seniors In Action sponsored Birthday Party and have cake and refreshments with your friends.

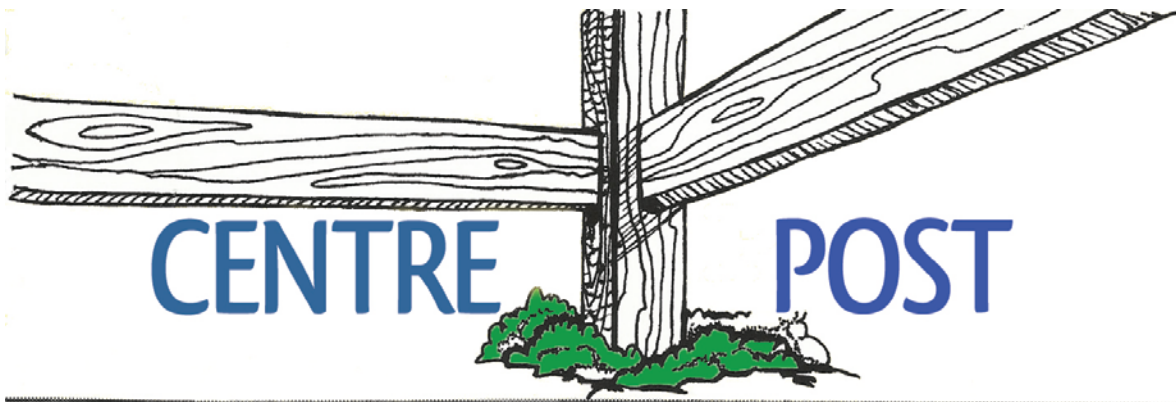
Furniture and Pets

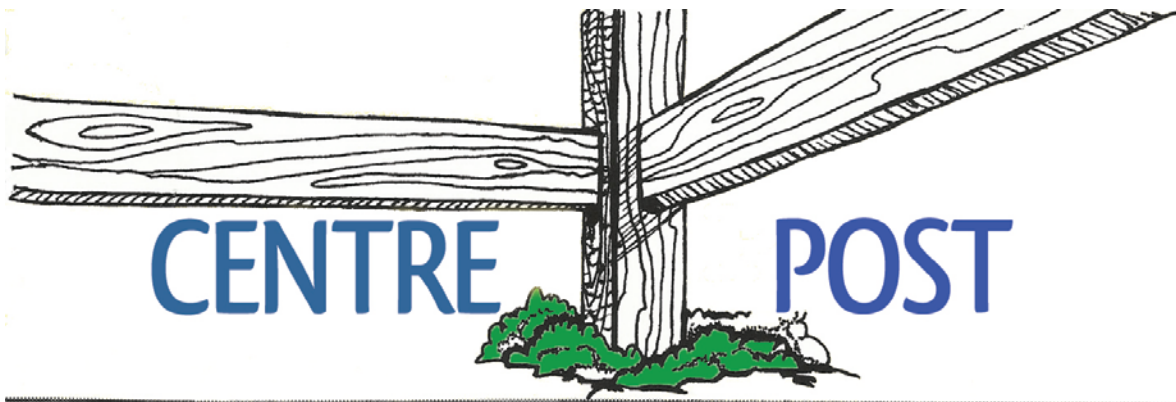
Reminder for Subsidized Residents
